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



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
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Event started with the singing of National Anthem together to unite all the present students. After this movie was started.



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






Fig.: The speaker was felicitated by Dr J. W. Bakal sir (Principal, PHCET)



Fig.: Mr K Priyesh Raghavan delivering a seminar on Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar






Date- 26/03/2023

The camp started early in the morning, and all the participants woke up to a beautiful day. After freshening up, the volunteers were served a nutritious breakfast.



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
Cleanliness drive at PHCET under 'Clean up Navi Mumbai'



About 35 volunteers with 2 faculty members coordinated the camp.

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

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
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


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International Women Day Celebration 2022



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



contributing in this noble mission of greening Bharat and the globe entirely. At the end of the



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


More than 25 lakh people have been affected by floods in Assam & Bihar and the situation is worsening.



Grocery Distribution During COVID 19

NSS Unit of Pillai HOC College of Engineering & Technology , rasayani always works for the people in the neighbourhood community. It has adopted village Gulsunde, Panvel on Dec 10th 2019. The population of this village is around 6000 out of which around 600 are tribes there where development is required. Currently all are aware of the COVID 19 situation and people are struggling for food because of lockdown. Government is also taking efforts and proving food stuff to all the people but is not enough for theml. So we decided to help in adopted village and identified the needy people through Village representative Mr. Manoj Pawar , Grampanchayat Member , Gulsunde. We appealed faculty members and students to donate voluntarily for this purpose . We collected 40,000 /- altogether from 50 faculty members and 6 students and brought grocery out of that. We bought Tur dal , Moong dal , Chana Dal , 1 litre Oil packets , 1 kg salt packets , onion , potato , soaps , etc. We made 100 food packets each containing 1 kg Tur dal , 1 kg Moong dal , 1 kg Chana Dal , 1 litre Oil packet , 1 kg salt packet , 1 kg onion , 1 kg potato ,2 soaps , oothpaste etc and distributed to 100 famillies in the tribal region of Gulsunde village on 21/04/2020. 












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
