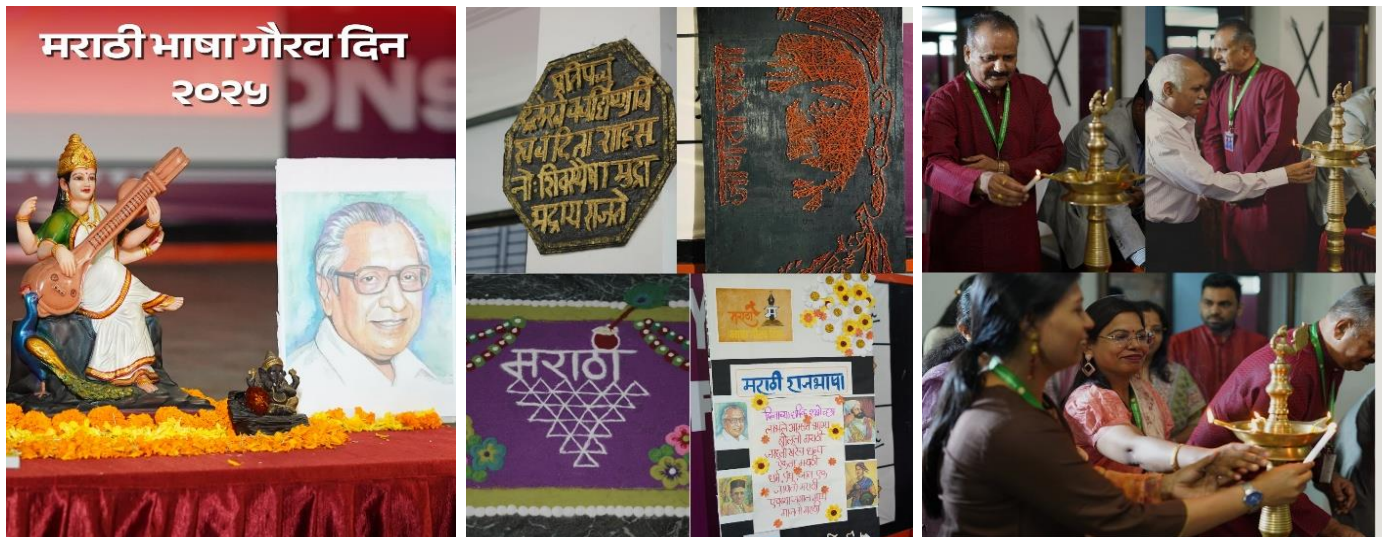


5. Marathi Bhasha Gaurav Din 2024-25
